

THE FALL HOUSING MARKET IS SPRINGING FORWARD!

A recent article in The Financial Times reports...The worst is over for North America's beleaguered housing markets, with a steady stream of data out of Canada and the U.S. indicating the recovery is at hand, economists say.



- ✓ “A similar pattern in both countries is unmistakably suggesting we've not only bottomed in housing, but we're on the way back up,” said TD Bank chief economist Don Drummond.
- ✓ The rebound in prices was evident even in most of Canada's hardest hit urban markets, like Toronto and Vancouver, the Teranet-National Bank report showed.
- ✓ For National Bank senior economist Marc Pinsonneault, that means “**the worst of home-price deflation in Canada is behind us,**” he said Wednesday.
- ✓ “The housing market has clearly turned the corner,” BMO Capital Markets economist Jennifer Lee said in an interview. “The items supporting a housing recovery have been working in tandem over the past while, and they are still going strong, like the Energizer bunny.”
